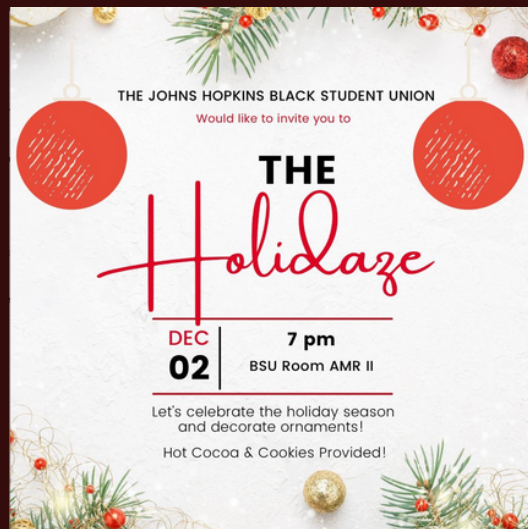
Finals Care Packages

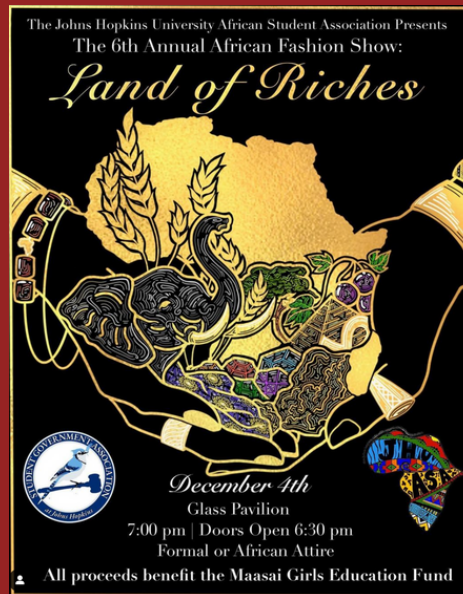

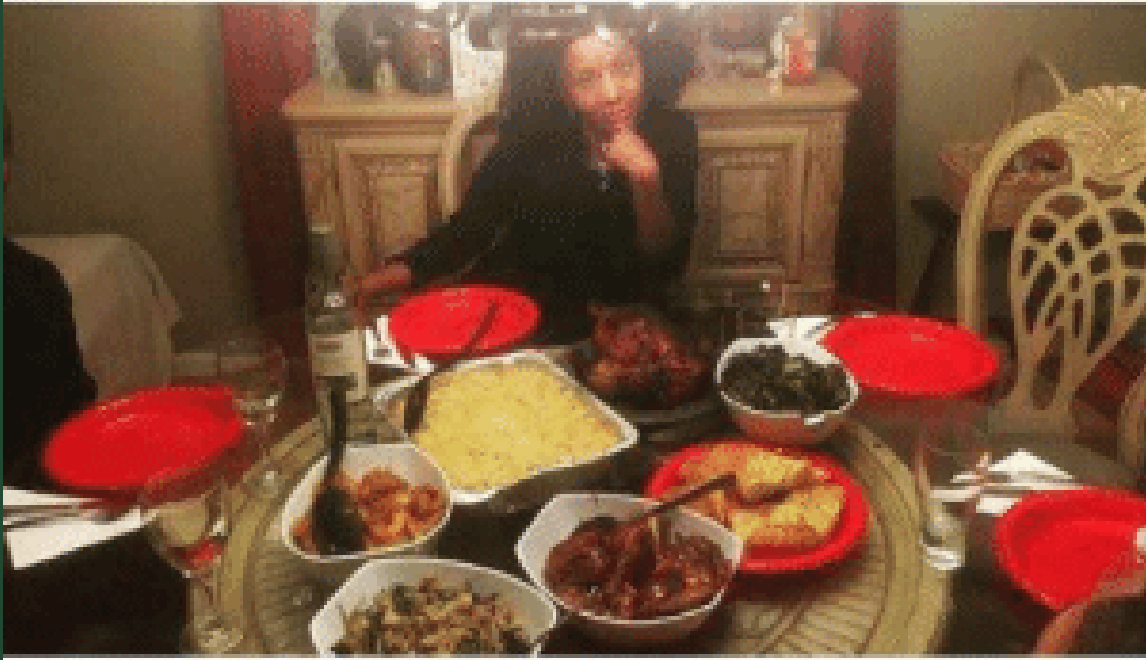
