Updates on Federal Actions and Budget Planning

- The university will **pause annual pay increases** for employees earning over \$80,000, with potential reevaluation in January 2026. Those earning \$80,000 or less (non-union) will receive a 2% raise effective July 1.
- A university-wide hiring freeze is in effect, with exceptions allowed for mission-critical or grant-funded roles.
- Capital projects will be reduced by 10–20%, prioritizing essential and advanced-stage projects, with final decisions made over the summer.
- To manage costs, **discretionary spending (e.g., travel, food, services) will be cut**, and divisions will identify additional efficiency and revenue opportunities in the coming months.

We understand that there are uncertain times, but we would like to let you know that GSA is always here to support our student body.
